

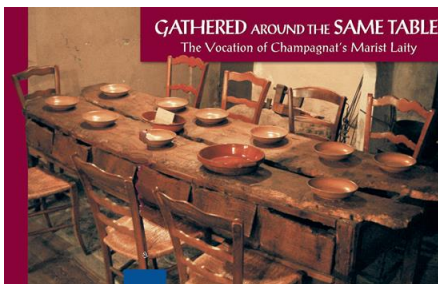


Champagnat Marist Lay

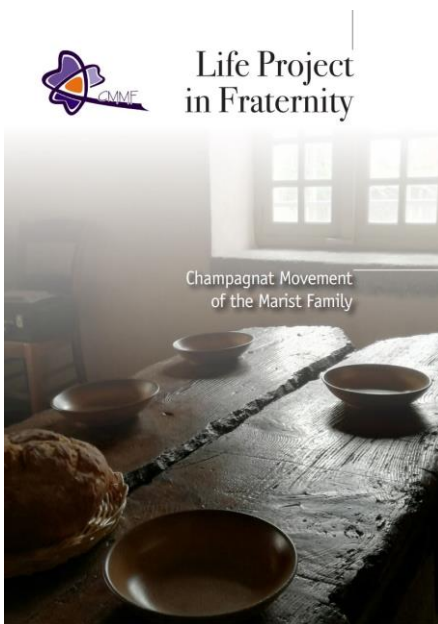
