CMI SOUTHERN AFRICA

THREE2SIX, JOHANNESBURG

The Three2Six Project in Johannesburg, South Africa, provides access to education for refugee children who have been denied their right to attend local schools. It utilises the classrooms of regular schools in the afternoon, from 3pm - 6pm (that's where the name is from) and employs refugee teachers to teach English, maths & life skills. Volunteers assist with administration and supporting families during the mornings and with classes, sports and computer lessons in the afternoons. 8 international and local volunteers live together in the Marcellin House Marist Young Adult Community located at one of the Three2Six schools. (placements normally 3 - 18 months), English



MARIST MERCY CARE, ADDO

Marist Mercy Care is a collaboration between the Marist Brothers and the Mercy Sisters in the rural communities around Addo in South Africa. They provide computer classes to adults and children in some of the local schools and also operate a children's creche and home based care health service in a local township. Each year one cmi international volunteer lives alongside one local South African volunteer in a cottage on the grounds of the Mercy sister's home and they join the sisters community for meals and community life. (placements normally 9 - 12 months, English)

ZOMBA MARIST SCHOOL, MALAWI

Zomba Catholic Secondary School is a national level Marist school in a large town, about 65kms from the city of Blantyre and 340kms from the capital, Lilongwe. In Malawi the Government cannot afford to provide high school education for all students, so only the rich and the very lucky can access high school. The Marist Brothers operate the regular day school during normal school hours, but then offer a late afternoon 'open' school to provide high school education for local village students. Volunteers live in a cottage next to the Brothers house and join the Brothers community for meals and community life. (placements from 3 - 12 months, English)





ST CHARLES LWANGA, MALAWI

St Charles Lwanda Secondary School is a Marist school in a small town, about 140kms from the city of Blantyre and 270kms from the capital, Lilongwe. In Malawi the Government cannot afford to provide high school education for all students, so only the rich and the very lucky can access high school. The Marist Brothers operate the regular day school during normal school hours, but then offer a late afternoon 'open' school to provide high school education for local village students. Volunteers live in a cottage in the teaching staff compound near the Brothers house and join the Brothers community for some meals and community life. (placements from 3 - 12 months, English)

NIVAVA, MOZAMBIQUE

The Marist Brothers run a school and local youth ministry activities in the rural town of Nivava in Mozambique. This is a remote location with very simple and limited town services. The volunteer assists with the school library and with the promotion of youth ministry in the local parish and community. Volunteers live in the Brothers community and join them for meals and community life. (placements from 6 - 12 months, Portuguese)



THREE2SIX HOLIDAY PROGRAM

The Three2Six Project runs a holiday program every December for 2 weeks. It provides the children with exposure to science, creative arts, music, craft, computers, sports and excursions, for which there is not time during the normal school hours. Volunteers come from around the world and locally to support the program, which is great fun each year! This is the perfect opportunity for volunteers who do not have an extended period of time to contribute to a wonderful local Marist program for marginalised children.
